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#### A Picture Worth a Thousand Words

he *Disrupting Democracy* series focuses on the impact of technology on political, economic and social ecosystems worldwide. In the first volume, we examined how technological innovations transformed countries at various stages of political and technological development. Our case studies – India, Germany, Israel, Cuba and the United States – demonstrated distinct experiences at the intersection of technology and democracy, but there were common themes that cut across all the countries. Bridging the urban-rural access divide, combatting disinformation and the displacement of traditional media presented policy challenges with which each government had to contend in their own ways.

In *Disrupting Democracy Volume II*, we probed more deeply in our research by conducting our work within the crucible of active election campaigns. Those pages tell the tales of the Democratic Party's "blue wave" in the US midterm elections, history-making victories for populism in Mexico and Italy, and Russia's ongoing attempts to influence electoral outcomes in neighboring Latvia. These cases revealed an unbalanced ledger of benefits and consequences of technology on campaigning, elections systems and governance.

For this third edition of the series, we decided to turn everything you've come to expect from Disrupting Democracy on its head. Rather than looking at the impact of technology on democracy, this volume will use technology to help us better explain democracy in the 21st century. Through the use of carefully constructed algorithms by our partners at the Institute for Competitiveness, we have collected data points that are the driving forces behind the volatility in democracy today. We've taken that raw data and converted it into a compendium of visualizations that provides a degree of depth that will take you well beyond any written analysis.

As the old saying goes, "A picture is worth a thousand words." If that adage is true, this visual journey to the United Kingdom, India, Brazil and the US will unlock new ways of thinking about the seismic shifts that have recently taken place in each country. It is our hope that this new perspective will serve as a springboard away from questioning what went wrong and towards devising what comes next, regardless of the disruptions that lie ahead.



#### Methodology

he data collection procedure starts by determining the research question. While the project is about analysing how democracies are changing across the world by studying four regions - UK, India, USA and Brazil, the focus and the exact problem statement differs across these studies and that impacts the data requirements. For instance, the UK study focuses on the transformative changes that led to Brexit. The existing literature pointed out that immigration, education levels, and rising inequality are the leading causes for the citizens to leave EU. Therefore, datasets providing information on economic and social factors related to UK's regions were located. On the other hand, while studying India the main question was how the average Indian voter makes his democratic choice and what factors play a predominant role in their minds. Therefore, a pool of datasets on the political landscape of the country were identified and studies providing data and results on voter behaviour were located.

Once all the data sources for the four regions were compiled, steps were taken to establish the relevance of the data. The applicability of data for the study was tested by studying original purpose of collecting the data and sampling strategies used (in case of survey data), time period of data collection and data collection protocols.

After evaluating the relevance of datasets and eliminating irrelevant datasets, the credibility of datasets was established. This was done by following three steps. First, using governmental data sources wherever possible. Second, determining the consistency of data by matching some data points from other sources. Third, by examining whether the datasets have been used in any credible research work, especially by the governmental departments.



he United Kingdom has always had a precarious relationship with the European Union. The country availed itself of the many benefits of membership while opting out of communal obligations when it suited. Perhaps it was no surprise, then, that this one-foot-in, one-foot-out approach to the EU would end in divorce. Attempts to separate had occasionally arisen, but none was more serious than the effort following Prime Minister David Cameron's announcement that the British electorate would decide on its EU membership in a referendum whose outcome became known as Brexit.

The fiercely contested campaign was marred by disinformation, nationalism and polarization. But on June 23, 2016, Britons voted to leave the EU, igniting a multi-year saga to iron out departure terms. The decision sent shockwaves that would disrupt the UK's and the bloc's economic, political and social orders. Where it goes from here is still murky, but this chapter will help cast light on the long road to Brexit.

UK population at-a-glance (2019)










#### Burning a Hole in Your Pocket






Internet penetration in the UK (2019)


Election turnout from 1945 to 2017



#### Who Gets the Biggest Piece of Pie?


UK parliamentary election share of the vote by party




rom selling tea out of his father's stall in the Indian state of Gujarat to becoming a two-term Indian prime minister, Narendra Modi's life is an incredible story. But that one-line summary glosses over a history that makes Modi a controversial figure. During his tenure as chief minister of Gujarat in 2002, communal riots left hundreds of Hindus and Muslims dead, and thousands more injured. Modi's role in the episode has been strongly questioned over the years culminating in the Supreme Court of India giving him a clean chit. Irrespective of how critics view Modi, his political career went from strength to strength, and he rode a rising wave of Hindu support straight into the halls of power.

Modi's political triumph is as complicated as India itself. In a country with many languages, religions and castes, and more than one billion people, the factors that dictate who will lead are seemingly infinite. Yet for two consecutive elections, Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has emerged as the unchallenged center of power in the country. And with that dominance, his administration has taken steps to consolidate its position, overwhelm the opposition and promote majority interests, causing consternation among Indian democratic activists.


To gain deeper insight into the country's electorate, this chapter goes back to the 2019 parliamentary election that extended Modi's term in office and gave the BJP a governing legislative majority. Chalking up Modi's victory exclusively to the rise of cultural nationalism doesn't provide the full picture. Access to technology, economic transformation and the main opposition party's decline must also be considered. These factors will feature prominently in the pages to follow.


Largest democracies by population







The Decline of the Congress Party

# Eroding Support for the Congress Party


Percentage of the vote for the Congress Party by caste






Electoral support for the BJP by caste



#### India's Other Sacred Cows


Economic performance is not the primary driver of voter preference

BJP victories at the state level across two election cycles








Annual income per capita since 2000 (in US\$)



hroughout its history, the United States has faced countless challenges to its democratic institutions and national character. The Civil War, Great Depression, Civil Rights Era and the aftermath of 9/11, for example, presented ample opportunity for Americans to abandon the foundations upon which the country was built. And though it wavered at times, its system of checks and balances withstood the pressures of the moment.


In the 2016 presidential election, the incremental erosion of public trust in government, expertise and American capitalism were among the factors that resulted in victory for Donald Trump, a businessman turned reality TV star turned right-wing populist. In the first two years of his presidency, Trump fanned the embers of discontent that got him elected. This strategy effectively solidified his base, brought Republican party officials to heel and completely polarized the US electorate.

Then came a midterm election in November 2018 full of contradictions. It featured an economy spouting a record high stock market, low unemployment figures and an electoral map favorable to Republicans. And yet, the election resulted in a blue wave as the Democratic Party swept the GOP out of power in the House of Representatives. Did Trump misjudge the country's tolerance for demonizing opponents, stigmatizing minority communities and growing public malfeasance or were other factors at play? This chapter examines the US descent into demagoguery to determine whether Americans will continue to go along for the ride.





Republican and Democratic presidential election outcomes since 1853




## Is the Ballot Box Half-Full or Half-Empty?









## Make America Go Back to Work Again

17 states had unemployment rise in 2015. Trump won 13 of them.




# Waiting in Line for Change



Percentage of US population with a social media profile from 2008 to 2019











or decades, Latin American observers have described Brazil as the country of the future. Then, taking a deep breath, they add "And it always will be." But there is much truth to this tired joke. A country vast in resources, cultural heritage and magnificent sights is perpetually crippled by economic mismanagement, gross inequality and staggering levels of corruption.


In 1985, democratic rule was restored to Brazil after two decades of dictatorship. But the dividends of political stability failed to be distributed equally across the population. The results were predictable. As in many other parts of the world, when establishment and technocratic leaders fall short, populists are quick to capitalize. In Brazil, the people's champion came in the form of President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, who made notable strides in raising the standard of living of Brazil's poorest communities. Lula's successes, however, were overshadowed by corruption scandals that dogged his administration and eventually landed him in prison. His successor, Dilma Rousseff, was impeached for corruption. Operation Car Wash, the source of her downfall, also snared her successor, Michel Temer. He spent most of his tenure under an investigation that also incriminated Lula.

With a political establishment discredited and crime rates soaring, Brazil's 2018 presidential elections opened the door for Jair Bolsonaro, a populist candidate with authoritarian tendencies. He promised to restore order and clean house in a country desperate for reform and good governance. This chapter looks at the factors that propelled Bolsonaro's ascent to power. These same factors may keep him there.

Migration patterns in Brazil









Historical trends in voter turnout







Vote share for the Workers Party (PT)











#### Scene of the Crime

Intentional homicides (Per 100,000)










